



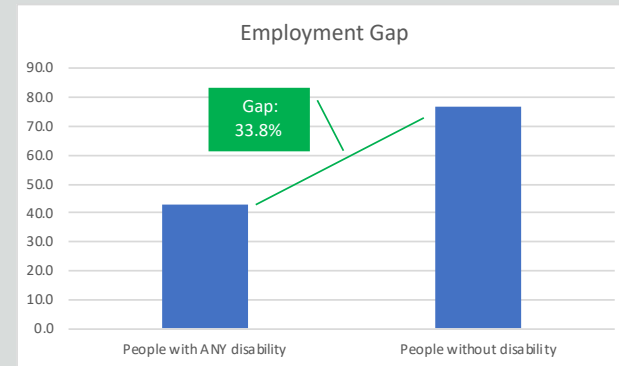
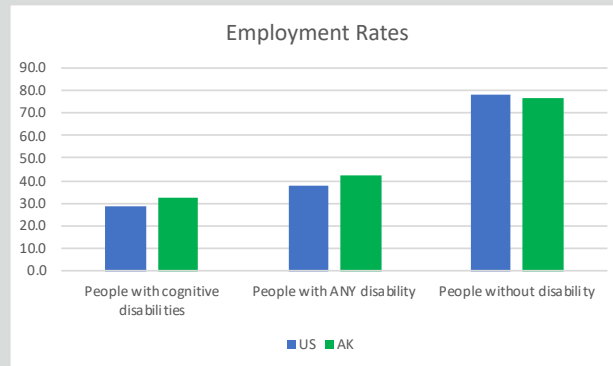
State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age Alaskans with disabilities are more likely to work than the national average. However, the employment gap between Alaskans with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of Alaskans with disabilities is below the national average. However, Alaskans with disabilities earn \$4,242 less on average than Alaskans without disabilities.
