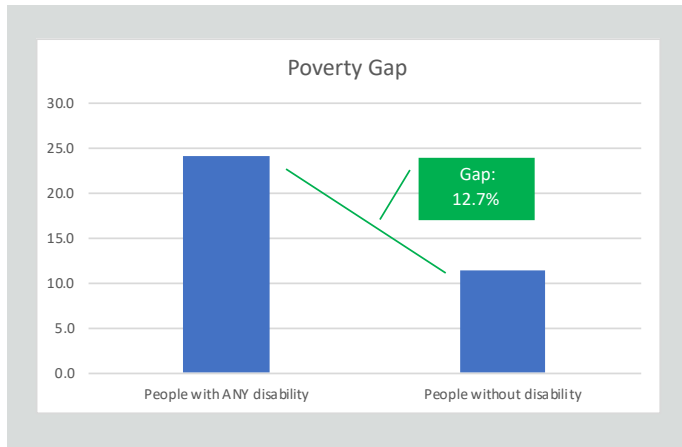
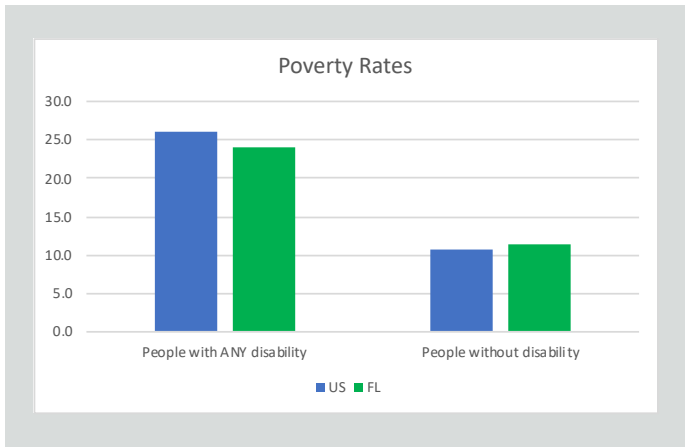
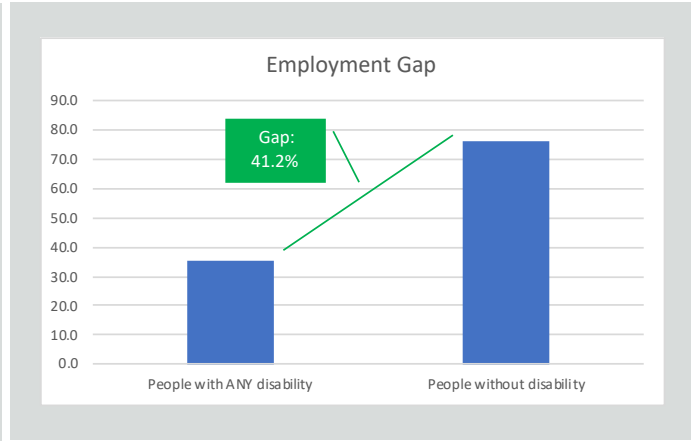
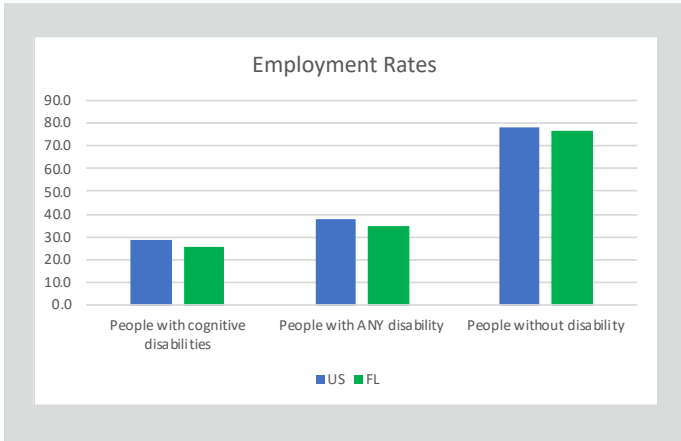




State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age Floridians with and without disabilities are less likely to work than the national average. The employment gap between Floridians with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of Floridians with disabilities is below the national average. However, Floridians with disabilities earn \$4,049 less on average than Floridians without disabilities.
