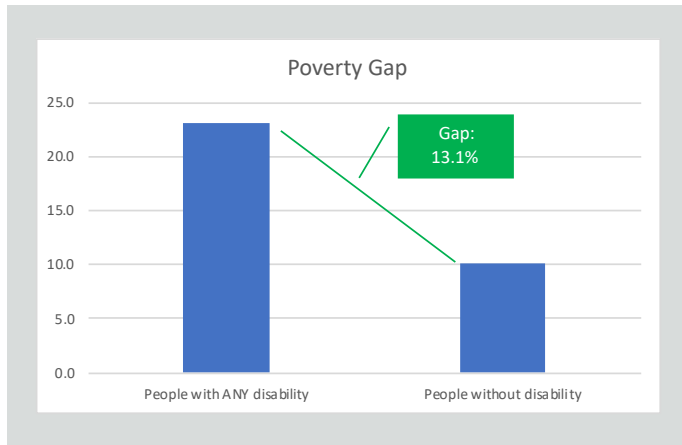
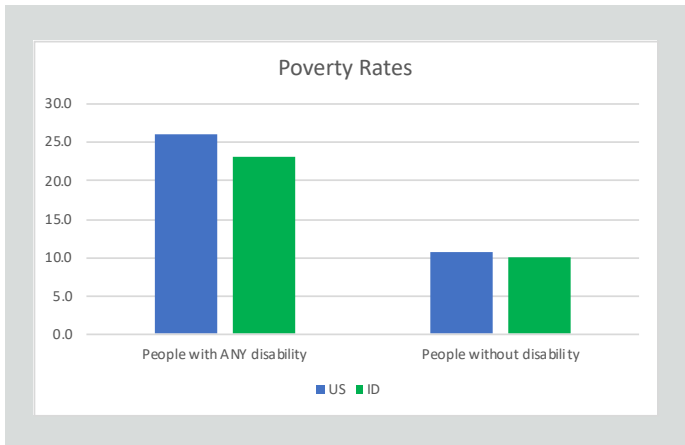
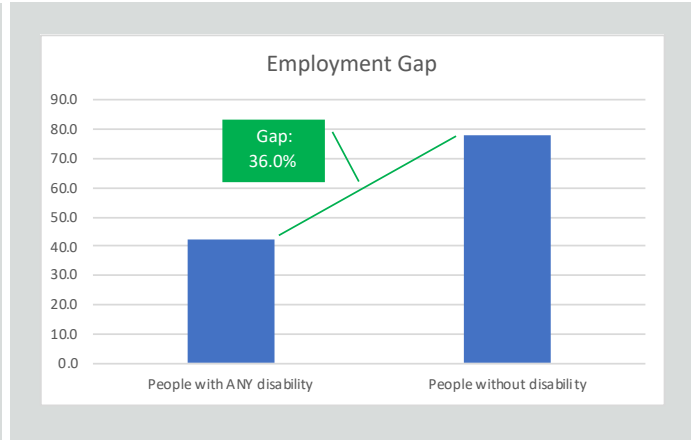
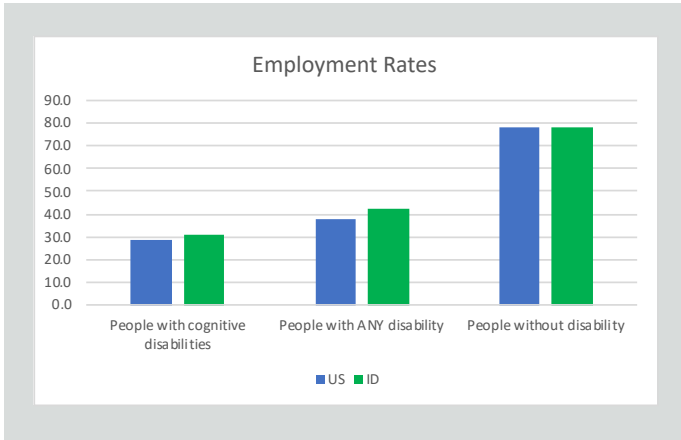




### State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age Idahoans with disabilities are more likely to work than the national average. However, the employment gap between Idahoans with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of Idahoans with and without disabilities is below the national average. However, Idahoans with disabilities earn \$6,364 less on average than Idahoans without disabilities.
