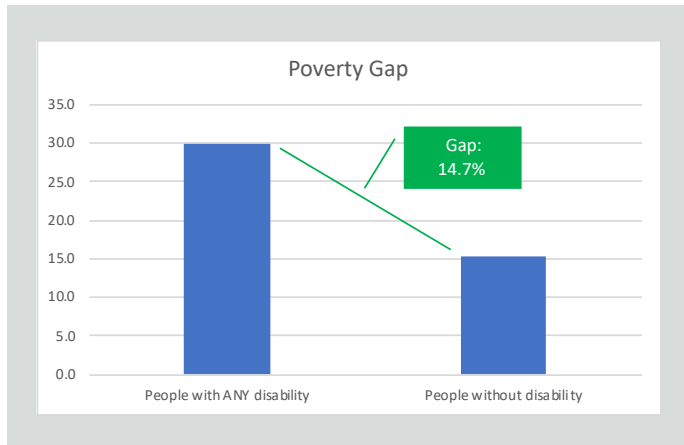
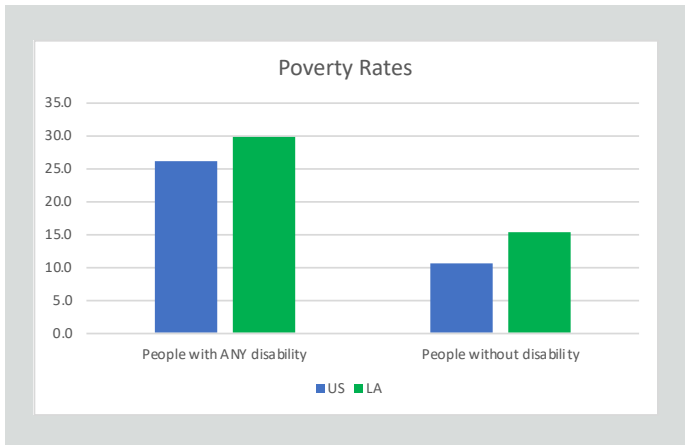
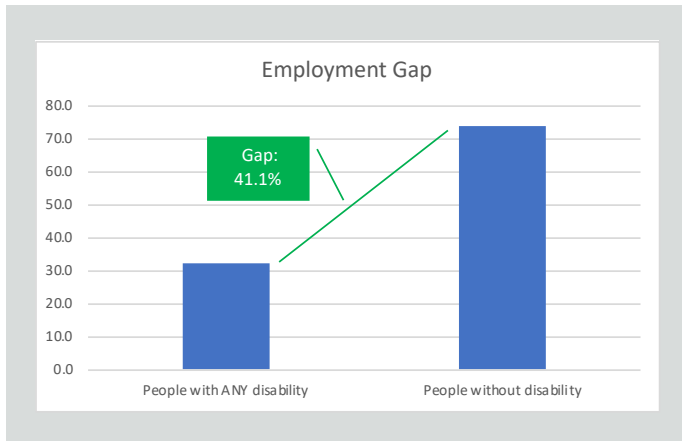
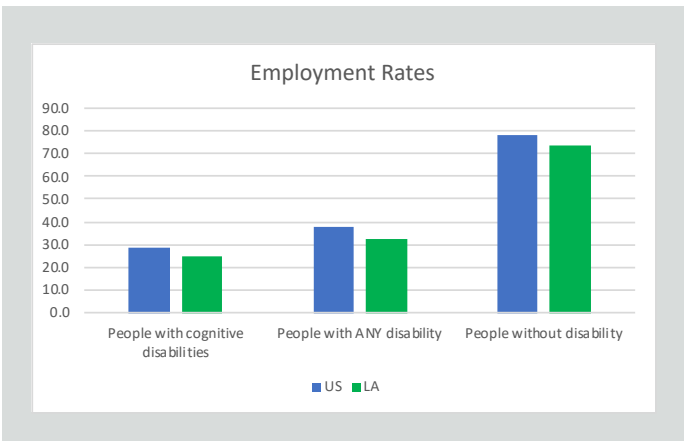


### State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age Louisianans with and without disabilities are less likely to work than the national average. Additionally, the employment gap between Louisianans with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of Louisianans with and without disabilities is above the national average. Louisianans with disabilities earn \$2,209 less on average than Louisianans without disabilities.
