

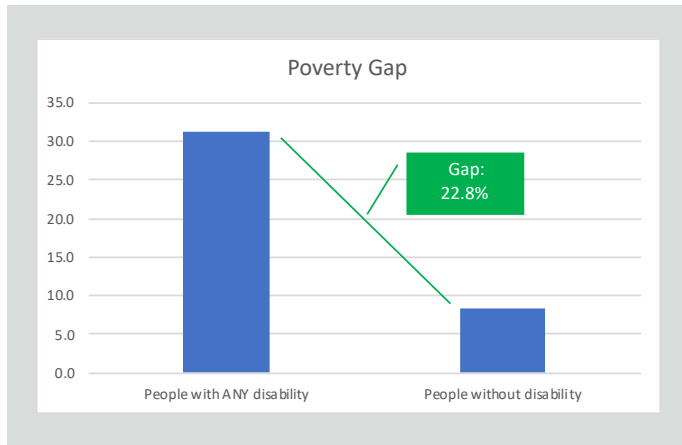
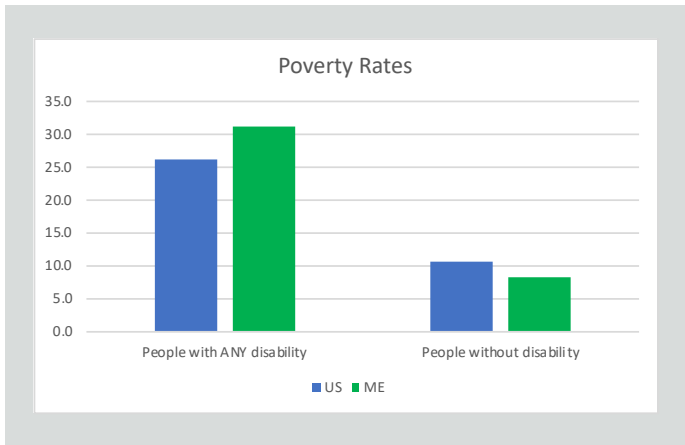
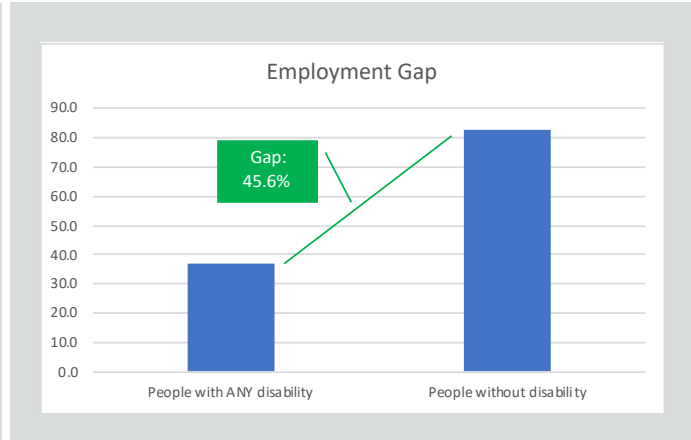
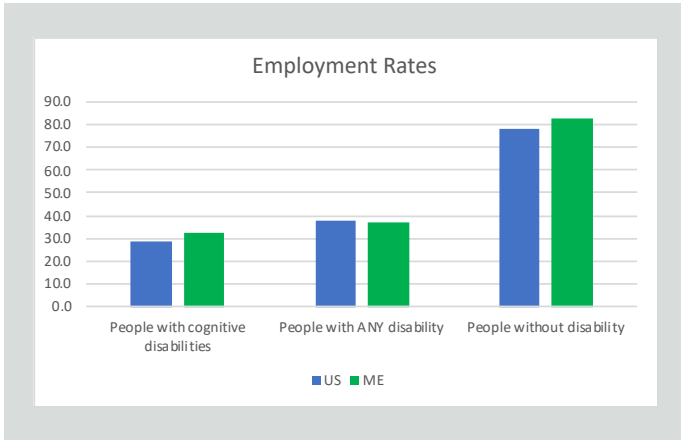


State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age Mainers with disabilities are less likely to work than the national average. The employment gap between Mainers with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of Mainers with disabilities is above the national average. Mainers with disabilities earn \$8,746 less on average than Mainers without disabilities.
