



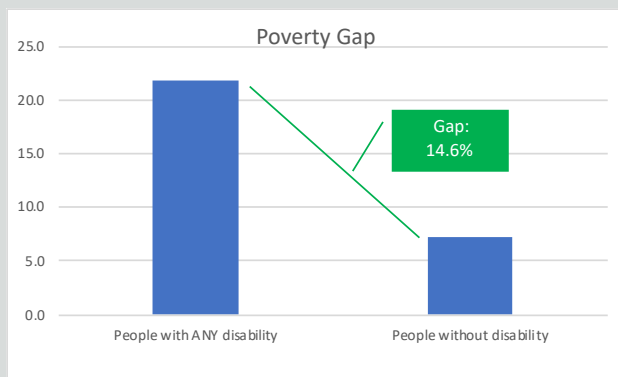
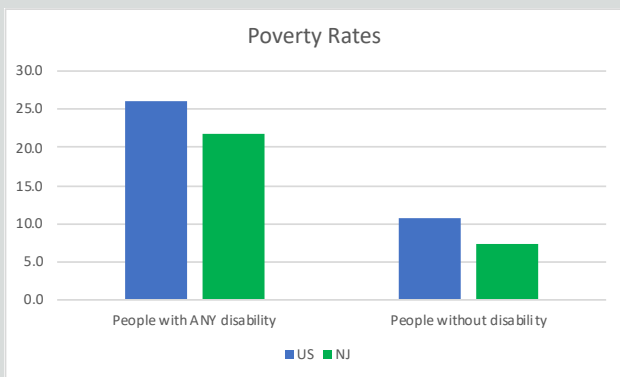
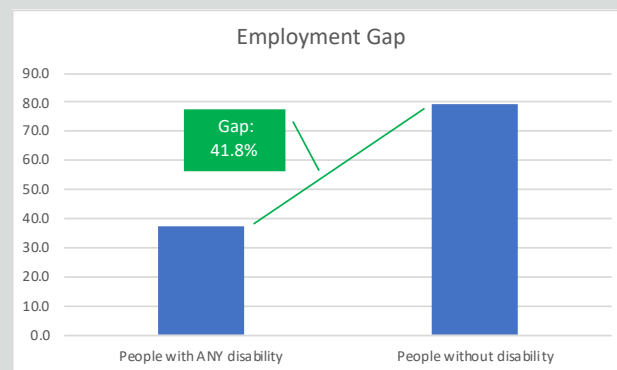
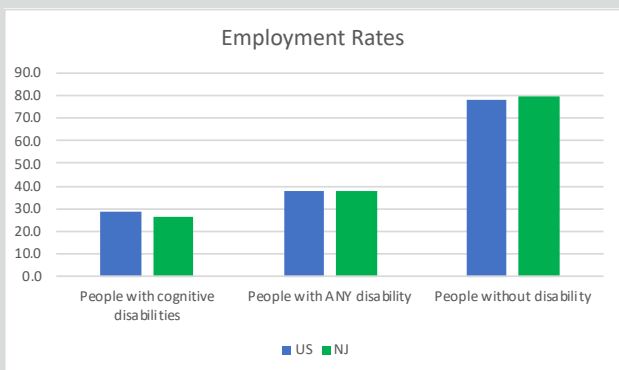
State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age New Jerseyans with disabilities are slightly less likely to work than the national average. The employment gap between New Jerseyans with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of New Jerseyans with and without disabilities is below the national average, but New Jerseyans with disabilities earn \$8,551 less on average than New Jerseyans without disabilities.
