

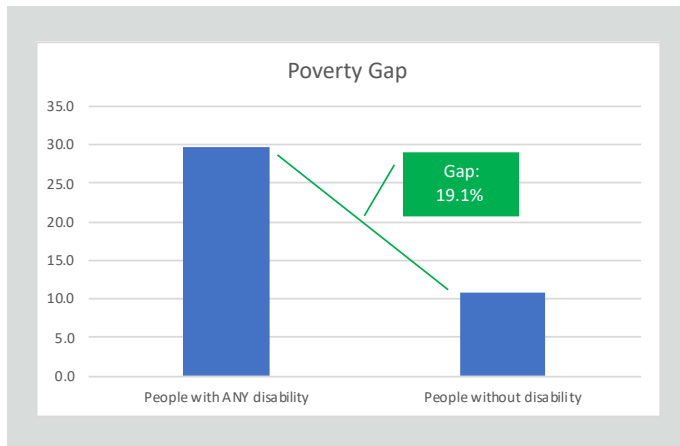
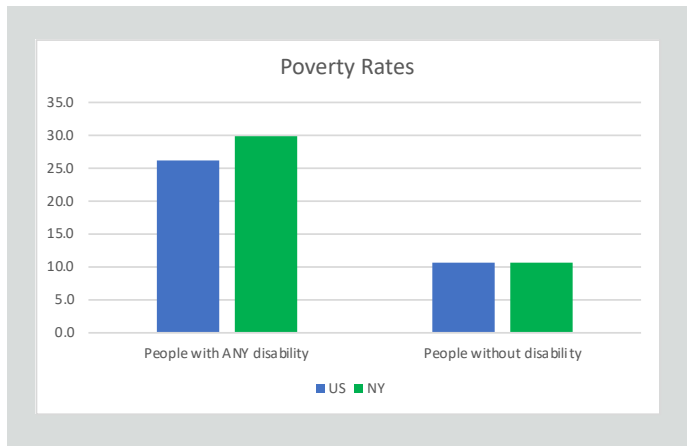
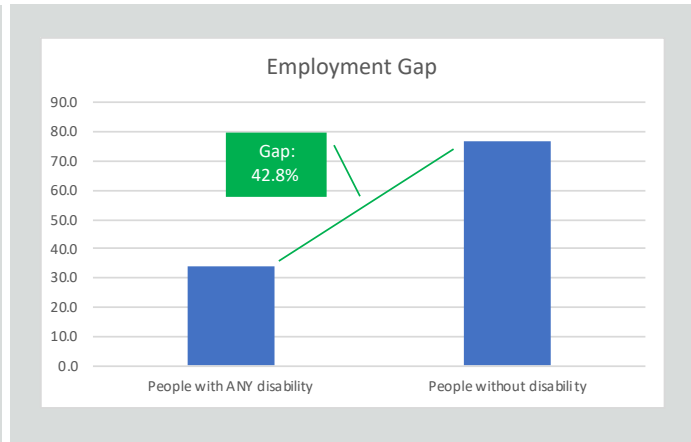
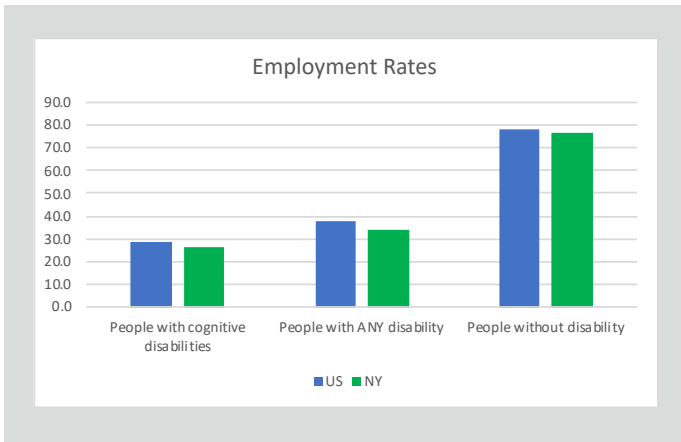


### State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age New Yorkers with and without disabilities are less likely to work than the national average. The employment gap between New Yorkers with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of New Yorkers with disabilities is above the national average. New Yorkers with disabilities earn \$6,607 less on average than New Yorkers without disabilities.
