



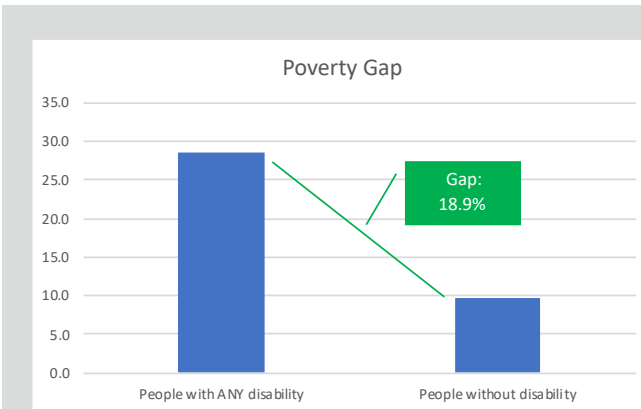
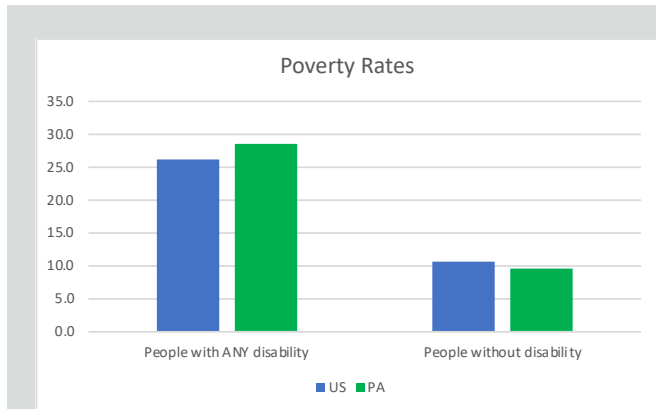
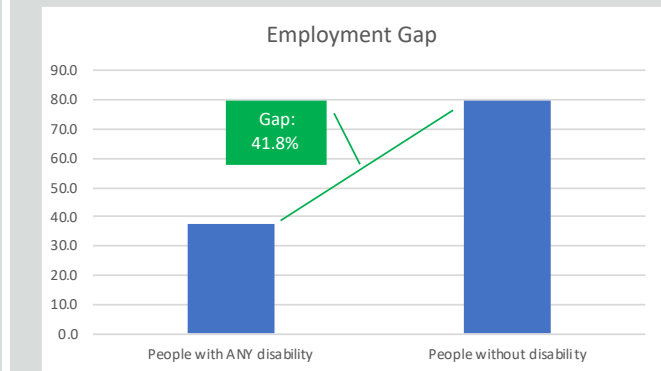
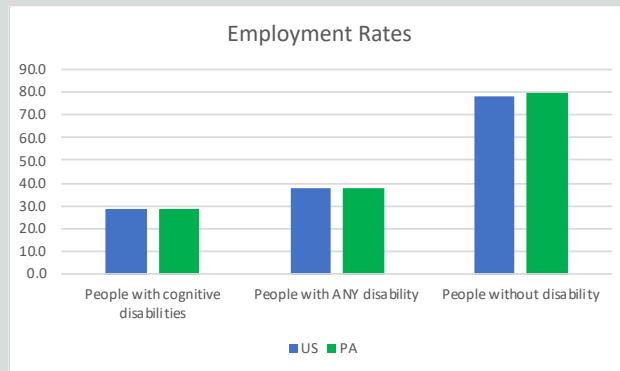
State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age Pennsylvanians with disabilities are less likely to work than the national average. The employment gap between Pennsylvanians with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of Pennsylvanians with disabilities is above the national average. Pennsylvanians with disabilities earn \$8,180 less on average than Pennsylvanians without disabilities.
