



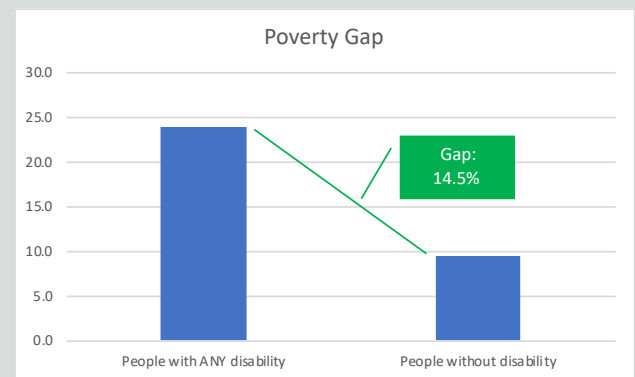
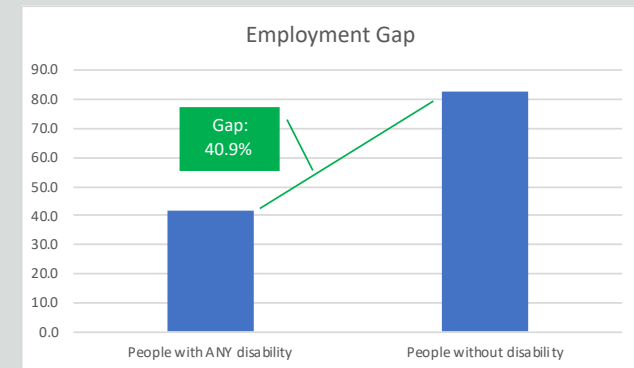
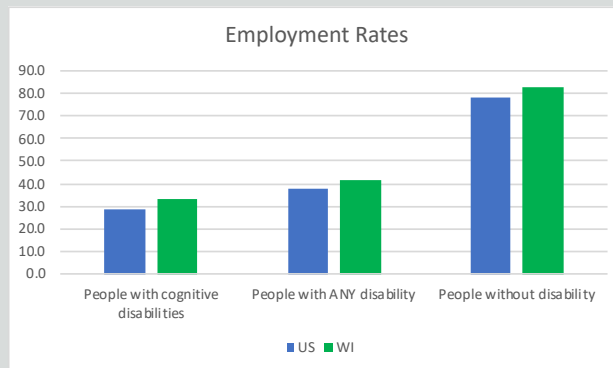
State Disability Employment Summary:

- Working-age Wisconsinites with and without disabilities are more likely to work than the national average. However, the employment gap between Wisconsinites with and without disabilities is wide.
- The rate of poverty of Wisconsinites with disabilities is below the national average. However, Wisconsinites with disabilities earn \$5,374 less on average than Wisconsinites without disabilities.
