



Certified Employment Support Professional™ (CESP) Credential 2019 Annual Report

The Certified Employment Support Professional™ (CESP) certification expanded to certify 563 new CESP.

With 1,167 candidates examined, the number of certificants grew to 3,427 as of 12/31/2019.

There were four versions of the examination used in 2019, with at least 1-2 new forms per year. The ESPCC is dedicated to continually updating and improving the examination using Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) and engaging CESP.

CESP credential holders are required to recertify every three years. The recertification process provides CESP with the opportunity to demonstrate the reinforcement, retention, and maintenance of their knowledge and skills and the retention of their knowledge of current practice. CESP credential holders showed their dedication to improving their skills and knowledge through either through continuing education credits or by sitting for the CESP™ exam.

Of the 988 eligible in 2019, 280 professionals recertified with a total of a 28% recertification rate.
